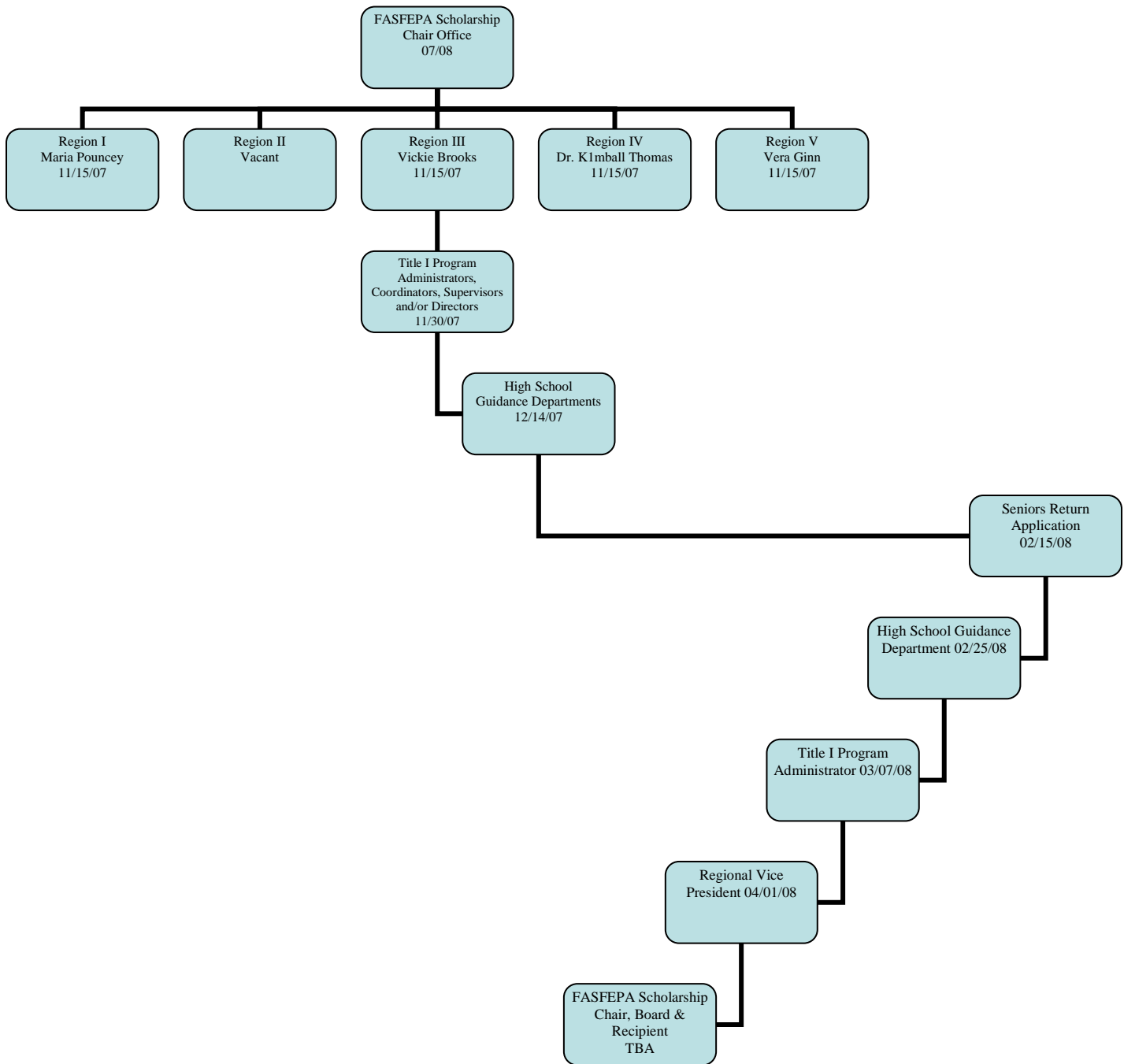

To: Senior Students – Will return to School Guidance Department no later than **February 15, 2008**

To: High School Guidance Department - Mail out to Title I Program Administrators no later than **February 25, 2008**

To: Title I Program Administrators - Mail out to Regional Vice Presidents no later than **March 7, 2008**
